Anchorage Connector Disinfection Procedure

Considering the severity of the recent COVID-19 pandemic, we at ClimbTech feel it is in the best interest for our customers to be informed on the precautious practice of product disinfection. Please read the following manuscript on how to effectively clean and disinfect our products to help reduce the public spread of COVID-19.

Cleaning

Per the user instruction for periodical maintenance cleaning, use a mild detergent and hot water solution followed by an overall wiping with a clean dry cloth and allow to dry by hanging in a well-ventilated area or by using compressed air.

Disinfection

The preferred method to disinfect all ClimbTech anchorage connector components is the application of 90% isopropyl alcohol with a clean cloth to all exposed high-touch surfaces. 70% alcohol may be used as an alternative, but additional drying time will be required. This method is an ideal option to remove the risk of disease transmission without going through a full wash and dry procedure.

Please read all and warning provided with the IPA to ensure proper handling.

Refrain from using any corrosive or degrading substances that may alter the appearance or shape of the product. If products are composed of webbing or stitching do not use substances such as bleach, chlorine, muriatic acid, sulfuric acid etc. As these can be detrimental to the strength of the product. Follow the prescribed cleaning procedure for these products.
